Development Practices focuses on effective
instruction for English learners (ELs) and
exploration of the EL components in literacy
programs. (2 Sessions)

**Vocabulary Workshop** focuses on best practices to develop vocabulary knowledge aligned to the Language Standards in elementary students.

Language Conventions and Writing
Fundamentals focuses on teaching language
conventions and writing to both primary- and
upper-grade elementary students, from basic
sentence construction through longer


